Content	Writing — code as well as text — is at the centre of most research projects. We write typically in numerous sittings, on multiple computers, together with collaborators, and over a long period of time to complete a single project. At the end of every sitting (by each collaborator, on each computer, and so on), essentially a different version of the same document(s) and folder(s) is created. With many versions created over time, there emerges several challenges, including: • keeping track of changes and versions • reverting to a previous version when necessary • communicating the versions to other authors and/or computers • working on the same project with co-authors at the same time This workshop will introduce you to Git and GitHub, in a workflow suited to address these challenges.
Prerequisites/	This workshop is for complete beginners, and prior knowledge of Git or GitHub is not required.
Materials	You should install <u>Git</u> and <u>GitHub Desktop</u> to your computer, and set up a free <u>GitHub</u> account before the workshop. Please <u>contact Resul</u> if you have any questions.
