Content	This workshop will guide you in building websites for academics and/or academic projects. Many believe that having a professional website is important for us academics, not only for impression management, but also for public
	outreach. Indeed, an online presence through a dedicated website can increase the recognition of our name and work. In this workshop we will learn how to use <u>Bloqdown</u> — an R package that facilitates building websites with <u>Hugo</u> . Together, they offer a flexible, efficient, and a free-of-charge workflow for academics in building and maintaining websites. Although <u>numerous website themes are available</u> , we will work with
	the Academic theme to facilitate coordination during the workshop. We will learn how to choose a theme, personalise the style and content, publish the resulting website, and how to maintain it afterwards. Note that you do not have to publish the website that you build. Some participants make their website available online during the workshop, others prefer to keep it on their computer for later. Both groups of participants are encouraged to register for this workshop.
Prerequisites/ Materials	The workshop assumes basic knowledge of R programming language. If you have no experience with R, but willing to familiarise yourself with it before the workshop, please contact Resul in advance to discuss your options.
